



- Integrated approach









2. eServices

- Accessible anytime and anywhere
- Reduce administrative burdens
- Reduce costs
- Streamline processes
- Minimize paperwork
- Freeing up resources









3. Biometric authentication and verification

- Forecasting trends and anticipate changes










6. Artificial Intelligence

- Enhancing Caregiver Support




